Drug delivery is a process of administering therapeutics to treat human diseases. The first drug delivery system is often dated to the 1950s, when Smith Kline & French Laboratories introduced the Spansule technology. Between 1950s and 1980s, there were four drug release systems developed for oral and transdermal applications: dissolution, diffusion, osmosis, and ion-exchange controlled release. Later in the 1980s, the Lupron Depot technology further advanced the field by offering zero-order and long-term release...

Cancer research ranges from epidemiology, molecular bioscience to the performance of clinical trials to evaluate and compare applications of the various cancer treatments. These applications include surgery, radiation therapy, chemotherapy, hormone therapy, immunotherapy and combined treatment modalities such as chemo-radiotherapy. Starting in the mid-1990s, the emphasis in clinical cancer research shifted towards therapies derived from biotechnology research, such as cancer immunotherapy and gene therapy.

Chlorpromazine is in the typical antipsychotic class, and, chemically, is one of the phenothiazines. Its mechanism of action is not entirely clear but is believed to be related to its ability as a dopamine antagonist. It has antiserotonergic and antihistaminergic properties.

In low doses it is used to treat agitated depression (together with an antidepressant). Fixed combinations of perphenazine and the tricyclic antidepressant amitriptyline in different proportions of weight exist (see Etrafon below). When treating depression, perphenazine is discontinued as fast as the clinical situation allows. Perphenazine has no intrinsic antidepressive activity. Several studies show that the use of perphenazine with fluoxetine (Prozac) in patients with psychotic depression is most promising, although fluoxetine interferes with the metabolism of perphenazine, causing higher plasma levels of perphenazine and a longer half-life. In this combination the strong antiemetic action of perphenazine attenuates fluoxetine-induced nausea and vomiting (emesis), as well as the initial agitation caused by...

It is used in the treatment of various conditions, most notably obsessive-compulsive disorder but also many other disorders, including hyperacusis, panic disorder, major depressive disorder, trichotillomania, body dysmorphic disorder and chronic pain. used. Common side effects include dry mouth, constipation, loss of appetite, sleepiness, weight gain, sexual dysfunction, and trouble urinating. It has also been notably used to treat premature ejaculation and the cataplexy associated with narcolepsy 4473fccd0b

Methylphenidate reduces core ADHD symptoms and is thought to do so primarily by increasing dopamine and norepinephrine activity in the brain. It may also improve aspects of executive functions, including working memory, sustained attention, and inhibitory control. In clinical use, the effects are generally described as lasting for several hours, although individual response varies substantially between formulations and patients. 4473fccd0b Perphenazine is roughly ten times as potent as chlorpromazine at the dopamine-2 (D2) receptor; thus perphenazine is considered a medium-potency antipsychotic. 4473fccd0b

Opipramol Despite chemically being a tricyclic dibenzazepine (iminostilbene) derivative similar to imipramine, opipramol is not a monoamine reuptake inhibitor like most other tricyclic antidepressants, and instead acts primarily as a sigma-1 receptor agonist. It was developed by Schindler and Blattner in 1961. depression. However, it does act as a high affinity antagonist of Opipramol, sold under the brand name Insidon among others, is an anxiolytic and tricyclic antidepressant that is used throughout Europe. Unlike other TCAs, opipramol does not inhibit the reuptake of serotonin or norepinephrine 4473fccd0b

Methylphenidate, sold under the brand names Ritalin and Concerta, among others, is a central nervous system (CNS) stimulant used primarily in the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and narcolepsy. It is also used to treat hyperactivity and impulsive behavior in people with ADHD. For ADHD, the effectiveness of methylphenidate is generally comparable to atomoxetine, but its effect is modestly lower than that of amphetamine. However, methylphenidate is generally preferred as a first-line treatment in children, while amphetamine-based medications are often preferred in adults. It may be taken by mouth or applied to the skin, and different formulations have varying durations of effect 4473fccd0b

The medication is taken by mouth. Bupropion has several features that distinguish it from other antidepressants: it does not usually cause sexual dysfunction, it is not associated with weight gain or sleepiness, and it is more effective than SSRIs at improving symptoms of hypersomnia and fatigue. Some evidence-based guidelines support first-line use. It is a norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRI). It is also popular as an add-on medication in the cases of "incomplete response" to the first-line selective serotonin reuptake inhibitor (SSRI) antidepressant 4473fccd0b

Citalopram In some European countries, it is sometimes given intravenously (injected into a vein) to initiate treatment, before switching to the oral route of administration for continuation of treatment. Its absorption does not increase when taken with food, but doing so can help prevent nausea. It is typically taken orally (swallowed by mouth). evening. It has also been used intravenously in other parts of the world in some other circumstances. It can be taken with or without food. The antidepressant effects may take one to four weeks to occur. It is used to treat major depressive disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, panic disorder, and social anxiety disorder.
