1899 San Ciriaco hurricane It slowly strengthened while heading steadily west-northwestward across the Atlantic Ocean and reached hurricane status by late on August 5. The storm weakened slightly before making landfall in Guayama, Puerto Rico with winds of 140 mph (220 km/h) on August 8. The third tropical cyclone and first major hurricane of the season, this storm was first observed southwest of Cape Verde on August 3. It was also one of the deadliest Atlantic hurricanes in recorded history, with an estimated 3,800 fatalities. During the following 48 hours, the Cape Verde hurricane deepened further, reaching Category 4 on the modern day Saffir-Simpson hurricane wind scale (SSHWS) before crossing the Leeward Islands on August 7.
