In March 1916, it was renumbered as the 3rd Mounted Division and in July 1916 as the 1st Mounted Division. The 3rd Mounted Division was a Yeomanry Division of the British Army active during World War I. It remained in the United Kingdom throughout the war and was disbanded in June 1919. It was formed on 6 March 1915 as the 2/2nd Mounted Division, a replacement/depot formation for the 2nd Mounted Division which was being sent abroad on active service. 1st Mounted Division and Derby The 1st Mounted Division was a Yeomanry Division of the British Army active during World War I. The divisional order of battle changed often, as the 1st Line brigades left for service overseas and were replaced by 2nd Line formations. outbreak of World War I, from four existing mounted brigades of the Territorial Force - Eastern, 1st South Midland, 2nd South Midland, and Notts. It was formed in August 1914 for the home defence of the United Kingdom from four existing mounted brigades of the Territorial Force, each of three regiments of Yeomanry. It remained in East Anglia throughout its existence. It was converted to the 1st Cyclist Division in July 1916, and was broken up in November 1916 without being involved in active service d381f98f6e

The division fought in France in World War I. In World War II, it landed with General Patton's task force in a contested amphibious landing on the coast of Morocco, North Africa,

overwhelming Vichy French defenders in November 1942. In 1943, the division invaded Sicily in July, and invaded Italy at Salerno in September, before fighting in France and finally Germany...

Scottish Horse It amalgamated with the Fife and Forfar Yeomanry to form the Fife and Forfar Yeomanry/Scottish Horse in 1956. units. The 1st and 2nd Scottish Horse The Scottish Horse was a Yeomanry regiment of the British Army's Territorial Army raised in 1900 for service in the Second Boer War. Later, a 3rd Line was formed to act as a reserve, providing trained replacements for the 1st and 2nd Line regiments. The lineage is maintained by "C" Fife and Forfar Yeomanry/Scottish Horse Squadron of The Scottish and North Irish Yeomanry based in Cupar in Fife. It saw heavy fighting in both the First World War, as the 13th Battalion, Black Watch, and in the Second World War, as part of the Royal Artillery d381f98f6e

These brigades were often part of larger military formations composed of units from the United Kingdom, Dominions, British India and Crown Colonies. At the time, despite their multi-national
