Due to stadium limitations, indoor combined events competition have a reduced number of events, resulting in the men's heptathlon and the women's pentathlon. Indoors, both men and women compete in the tetradecathlon, with slightly different events to the women's outdoor version. Athletes are allocated points based on an international-standard points scoring system, such as the decathlon scoring table. Outdoors, the most common combined events are the men's decathlon and the women's heptathlon 95b8d8ca91

Traditionally, the title of "World's Greatest Athlete" has been given to the person who wins the decathlon.
