A host of factors contributed to the environment in which atrocities were committed across the continent, ranging from general racism (including antisemitism), religious hatred, blind obedience, apathy, political opportunism, coercion, profiteering, and xenophobia. He attended multiple elementary schools in the Sacramento and Sonoma Valleys before completing high school at Healdsburg High School in the Sonoma Valley. He earned his Bachelor of Arts in history with distinction and Phi Beta Kappa from the University of California, Berkeley in 1963, after which he taught fifth grade in multilingual classrooms in Porterville, California, Pearson then entered the doctoral program in reading education at the University of Minnesota, where he received his Ph.D. in 1969. a7d75dfb75 While similar models have been identified and represented throughout the study and development of teaching and learning as a construct, it was P. David Pearson and Margaret C. Gallagher (1983) who coined the phrase "gradual release of responsibility" to describe this dynamic in the classroom. Loosely basing their model on the ideas of the Russian educational theorist Lev Vygotsky, Pearson and Gallagher envisioned instruction that moved from explicit modeling and instruction to guided practice and then to activities that incrementally positioned students into becoming independent learners.
