Woodlice have many common names and although often referred to as terrestrial isopods, some species live semiterrestrially or have recolonised aquatic environments like those of the genus *Ligia*. Around this time, Eschscholtz discovered three species of the Gerridae, bringing attention to the species, though little of their biology was known.
