Homonymous hemianopsia (or homonymous hemianopia) is hemianopic visual field loss on the same side of both eyes.

Homonymous hemianopsia occurs because the right half of the brain has visual pathways for the left hemifield of both eyes, and the left half of the brain has visual pathways for the right hemifield of both eyes. Eriksen flanker task The task is named for American psychologists Barbara A. In the tests, a directional response (usually left or right) is assigned to a central target stimulus. The target is flanked by non-target stimuli which correspond either to the same directional response as the target (congruent flankers), to the opposite response (incongruent flankers), or to neither (neutral flankers). Eriksen, who first published the task in 1974, and for the flanker stimuli that surround the target. which correspond either to the same directional response as the target (congruent flankers), to the opposite response (incongruent

flankers), or to neither. In cognitive psychology, the Eriksen flanker task is a set of response inhibition tests used to assess the ability to suppress responses that are inappropriate in a particular context.
