As of 2026, the only Millennium Prize problem to have been solved is the Poincaré conjecture. The Clay Institute awarded the monetary prize to Russian mathematician Grigori Perelman in 2010. However, he declined the award because it was not also offered to Richard S. Hamilton, upon

whose work Perelman built.

Hilbert's problems are 23 problems in mathematics published by German mathematician David Hilbert in 1900. The complete list of 23 problems was published later, and translated into English in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society. They were all unsolved at the time, and several proved to be very influential for 20th-century mathematics. Earlier publications (in the original German) appeared in Archiv der Mathematik und Physik. Hilbert presented ten of the problems (1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 19, 21, and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Congress of Mathematicians, speaking on August 8 at the Sorbonne [a1f6767eff](#)
