The Harbour Quays project was launched in July 2005 with the aim of developing CentrePort's land along Waterloo Quay, between Bunny St and the Sky Stadium, into a business park with office buildings, retail and recreational spaces. CentrePort said there was space for up to 12 multi-storey buildings to house 4000 workers. The first new building in the project was Statistics House, completed in 2005 and demolished in 2018 following earthquake damage. a217fdb585 She was one of four Saint-class ferries built by Harland & Wolff in Belfast for Sealink. a217fdb585 Douglas Harbour is composed of the Outer Harbour and the Inner Harbour separated by the Bascule Bridge and Flapgate. There is now a total of 14 members: five "head ports", two "ancient towns" and seven "limbs". At its peak in the Late Middle Ages, the confederation included over 40 members. The name is Old French, meaning "five harbours", and alludes to the original five members (Hastings, New Romney, Hythe, Dover and Sandwich) a217fdb585

They were of a double diagonal oak plank over lightweight teak frames hull construction (the diagonals of the inner and outer skins running in opposite directions & separated by a skin of oiled calico cloth), as were RNLI lifeboats of the era, making for an extremely light but strong construction a217fdb585

Lüshunkou is located at the extreme southern tip of the Liaodong Peninsula. It has a natural harbor, the possession and control of which became a casus belli of the Russo-Japanese War (1904–05). Japanese and then Russian administration was established in 1895 and continued until 1905 when control was ceded to Japan.
