Scunthorpe problem One solution The Scunthorpe problem is the unintentional blocking of online content by a spam filter, search engine or wordfilter because the text contains a string (or substring) of letters that appear to have an obscene or otherwise unacceptable meaning. The Scunthorpe problem is challenging to completely solve due to the difficulty of creating a filter capable of understanding words in context. Names, abbreviations, and technical terms are most often cited as being affected by the issue

Combinatorics on words is considered a relatively young area of mathematics. The subject originated with foundational work published by Axel Thue on square-free words, infinite words, and repetitions in the early 1900s and enjoyed some major results by Emil Post in the middle of the century. However, most research in the field has occurred since the 1980s. Economic systems attempt to solve these problems in several ways: "...by custom and instinct; by command and centralized control (in planned economies)" and in mixed economies using "...both market signals and government directives to allocate goods and resources." The latter is variously defined as an economic system blending elements of a market economy with elements of a planned economy, free markets with state interventionism, or private enterprise with public enterprise. The international conference WORDS, which has occurred biannually since 1997, focuses on combinatorics on words.

Hard problem of consciousness The easy problems are amenable to functional explanation—that is, explanations that are mechanistic or behavioural—since each physical system can be explained purely by reference to the "structure and dynamics" that underpin the phenomenon. It is contrasted with the "easy problems" of explaining why and how physical systems give rise to the ability to discriminate, to integrate information, and to perform behavioural functions such as watching, listening, speaking (including generating an utterance that appears to refer to personal behaviour or belief), and so forth.
