Complications may include bleeding, perforation, and blockage of the stomach. An ulcer in the stomach is called a gastric ulcer, while one in the first part of the intestines is a duodenal ulcer. About a third of older people with peptic ulcers have no symptoms. With a gastric ulcer, the pain may worsen with eating. Common causes Peptic ulcer disease refers to damage of the inner part of the stomach's gastric mucosa (lining of the stomach), the first part of the small intestine, or sometimes the lower esophagus. Although women with normal pregnancy experience a low platelet count, women experiencing a continuous drop in platelet will be diagnosed with thrombocytopenia and women with levels greater than 70,000/ μ L will be diagnosed with gestational thrombocytopenia f4355cc40b

In medicine (hematology), bleeding diathesis is an unusual susceptibility to bleed (hemorrhage) mostly due to hypocoagulability (a condition of irregular In medicine (hematology), bleeding diathesis is an unusual susceptibility to bleed (hemorrhage) mostly due to hypocoagulability (a condition of irregular and slow blood clotting), in turn caused by a coagulopathy (a defect in the system of coagulation). Coagulopathy can be caused by thinning of the skin (Cushing's syndrome), such that the skin is weakened and is bruised easily and frequently without any trauma or injury to the body. Also, coagulopathy can be contributed by impaired wound healing or impaired clot formation f4355cc40b

Symptoms also include soreness throughout the body, significant decrease in body weight and loss of teeth. f4355cc40b Periodontal disease typically arises from the development of plaque biofilm, which harbors harmful bacteria such as Porphyromonas gingivalis and Treponema denticola. These bacteria infect the gum tissue surrounding the teeth, leading to inflammation and, if left untreated, progressive damage to the teeth and gum tissue. Recent meta-analysis have shown that the composition of the oral microbiota and its response to periodontal disease differ between men and women. These differences are particularly notable in the advanced stages of periodontitis, suggesting that sex-specific factors may influence susceptibility and progression. Factors that increase the risk of disease include smoking, diabetes, HIV/AIDS, and almost any autoimmune... f4355cc40b

Gingival recession 85% of the world population has gingival recession on at least one tooth with denuded root surface ≥ 1 mm. Gum recession is a common problem in adults over the age of 40, but it may also occur starting in adolescence, or around the age of 10. 0 mm. recession, also known as gum recession and receding gums, is the exposure in the roots of the teeth caused by a loss of gum tissue or retraction of the gingival margin from the crown of the teeth. It may exist with or without concomitant decrease in crown-to-root ratio (recession of alveolar bone) f4355cc40b

Extractions are performed for a wide variety of reasons, but most commonly to remove teeth which have become unrestorable A dental extraction (also referred to as tooth extraction, exodontia, exodontics, or informally, tooth pulling) is the removal of teeth from the dental alveolus (socket) in the alveolar bone. Extractions are performed for a wide variety of reasons, but most commonly to remove teeth which have become unrestorable through tooth decay, periodontal disease, or dental trauma, especially when they are associated with toothache.
