Today, over 100,000 living species bear a shell; there is some dispute as to whether these shell-bearing molluscs form a monophyletic group (conchifera) or whether shell-less molluscs are interleaved into their family tree.

Shells are actually special applications that use the kernel API in just the same way as it is used by other application programs. A shell manages the user-system interaction by prompting users for input, interpreting their input, and then handling output from the underlying operating system (much like a read-eval-print loop, REPL). Occasionally shell jewelry is made from the shells of non-marine mollusks such as the shells of land snails, or the shells of freshwater mollusks.
