Evaporative cooler This natural process can often cool air using much less energy than other forms of refrigeration. The temperature of dry air can be dropped significantly

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through the phase transition of liquid water to water vapor (evaporation). In extremely dry climates, evaporative cooling of air has the added benefit of raising the humidity and conditioning the air with more moisture for the comfort of building occupants. Evaporative cooling exploits the fact that water will absorb a relatively large amount of heat in order to evaporate (that is, it has a large enthalpy of vaporization). Humidity depends on the temperature and pressure of the system of interest. The same amount of water vapor results in higher relative humidity in cool air than warm air. A related parameter is the dew point. The amount of water vapor needed to achieve saturation increases as the temperature increases. As the temperature of a parcel of air decreases it

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will eventually reach the saturation point without adding or losing water mass. The amount of water vapor contained within a parcel of air can vary significantly. For example, a parcel of air near saturation may contain 8 g of water per cubic metre of air at 8 °C (46 °F), and 28 g of water per cubic metre of air at 30 °C (86 °F) 95f3d51578 Three primary measurements of humidity are widely employed: absolute, relative, and specific. Windcatchers come in various designs, depending on whether local prevailing winds are unidirectional, bidirectional, or multidirectional, on how they change with altitude, on the daily temperature cycle, on humidity, and on how much dust needs to be removed. It is possible for a windtower-ventilated building to have very high flow rates; A windcatcher, wind tower,

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or wind scoop (Persian: بادگیر, romanized: Badgir) is a traditional architectural element used to create cross ventilation and passive cooling in buildings 95f3d51578

Ventilation design considers both the amount and distribution of airflow. Ventilation rates may be expressed as volumetric flow, as airflow per person or unit of floor area, or as air changes per hour (ACH). Ventilation is commonly classified as natural ventilation, mechanical ventilation, or mixed-mode ventilation. Natural ventilation relies on passive forces such as wind pressure and the stack effect, while mechanical ventilation uses fans to move outdoor air into or out of a building.
