Once ultrasound or histological evidence shows that a pregnancy has existed, the term used is clinical miscarriage, which can be "early" (before 12 weeks) or "late" (between 12 and 21 weeks). Abortion The most common Abortion is the termination of a pregnancy by removal or expulsion of an embryo or fetus. Abortion occurring without intervention is known as spontaneous abortion or "miscarriage", and occurs in roughly 30–40% of all pregnancies. The unmodified word abortion generally refers to induced abortion, or deliberate actions to end a pregnancy. Other reasons include maternal health, an inability to afford a child, domestic violence, lack of

support, feelings of being too young, wishing to complete an education or advance a career, and not being able, or willing, to raise a child conceived as a result of rape or incest. first and second trimesters of pregnancy. Fetus Following the embryonic stage, the fetal stage of development takes place. Aetiology == 5f3ead3baa Overall, ectopic pregnancies annually affect less than 2% of pregnancies worldwide. Risk factors for ectopic pregnancy include pelvic inflammatory disease, often due to chlamydia infection; tobacco smoking; endometriosis; prior tubal surgery; a history of infertility; and the use of assisted

reproductive technology. Those who have previously had an ectopic pregnancy are at much higher risk of having another one. Most ectopic pregnancies (90%) occur in the fallopian tube, which are known as tubal pregnancies, but implantation can also occur on the cervix, ovaries, caesarean scar, or within the abdomen...

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Braxton Hicks contractions are contractions that occur during pregnancy, but before going into childbirth. They typically begin in the second or third trimester, but they may start as early as the sixth week of pregnancy. Braxton Hicks contractions, also known as practice contractions or false labour, are sporadic uterine contractions that occur during pregnancy, but before going into childbirth. They typically begin in the second or third trimester, but they may start as early as the sixth week of pregnancy.

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Signs and symptoms of early

pregnancy may include missed periods, tender breasts, morning sickness (nausea and vomiting), hunger, implantation bleeding, and frequent urination.

Pregnancy may be confirmed with a pregnancy test. Methods of contraception are used to avoid pregnancy. It can be associated with reduced fetal birth weight. Use of aspirin before 16 weeks of pregnancy to prevent pre-eclampsia also appears effective at preventing antepartum bleeding.

== Classification ==
Braxton Hicks contractions are often mistaken for labour, and are believed to allow the pregnant woman's body to prepare for labour. The presence of Braxton Hicks contractions does not mean a woman is in labour, nor even that labour is about to commence. Another common cause of pain in pregnancy is round ligament pain.

Signs and symptoms of pregnancy If a person is

concerned about their symptoms they should be encouraged to speak with an appropriate healthcare professional. Pregnancy symptoms may be categorized based on trimester as well as region of the body affected. Each pregnancy can be quite different and many people do not experience the same or all of the symptoms. Signs and symptoms of pregnancy typically change as pregnancy progresses, although several symptoms may be present throughout. Depending on severity, common symptoms in pregnancy can develop into complications. in the first trimester or bleeding associated with pain, may be a sign of a complication, such as a miscarriage or an ectopic pregnancy, that would need Signs and symptoms of pregnancy are common, benign conditions that result from the changes to the body that occur during pregnancy

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Conception usually occurs

following vaginal intercourse, but can also occur through assisted reproductive technology procedures. A pregnancy may end in a live birth, a miscarriage, an induced abortion, or a stillbirth. Childbirth typically occurs around 40 weeks from the start of the last menstrual period (LMP), a span known as the gestational age; this is just over nine months. Counting by fertilization age, the length is about 38 weeks. Implantation occurs on average 8–9 days after fertilization. An embryo is the term for the developing offspring during the first seven weeks following implantation (i.e. ten weeks' gestational age), after which the term fetus is used until the birth of a baby. In human prenatal development, fetal development begins from the ninth week after fertilization (which is the eleventh week of gestational age) and continues until the birth of a newborn.

Associated conditions == The

most common symptom of a miscarriage is vaginal bleeding, with or without pain. Tissue and clot-like material may leave the uterus and pass through and out of the vagina. Risk factors for miscarriage include being an older parent, previous miscarriage, exposure to tobacco smoke, obesity, diabetes, thyroid problems, and drug or alcohol use.
