They may weigh themselves frequently, eat small amounts, and only eat certain foods in order to be in as much control of their body appearance as possible. The specific toxins involved are ciguatoxins and maitotoxin. Serious and relatively common causes include acute coronary syndrome such as a heart attack (31%), pulmonary embolism (2%), pneumothorax, pericarditis (4%), aortic dissection (1%) and esophageal rupture. Other common causes include gastroesophageal reflux disease (30%), muscle or skeletal pain (28%), pneumonia (2%), shingles (0.5%), pleuritis, traumatic and anxiety disorders. Determining the cause of chest pain

is based on a person's medical history, a physical exam and other medical tests. About 3% of heart attacks, however, are initially missed.

The Ciguatera fish poisoning (CFP), also known as ciguatera, is a foodborne illness caused by eating tropical reef fish contaminated with ciguatoxins. diagnosis. At lower amounts, symptoms may take a few days to appear. ". Preventive efforts include not eating reef fish, not eating high-risk fish such as barracuda, and not eating fish liver, roe, or fish heads. If a large quantity of toxins is consumed, symptoms may appear within half an hour. Diarrhea may last up to four days. Shoemaker, House, and Ryan published a case definition of a chronic form of ciguatera poisoning that may develop: "Roughly 5% of these victims will develop chronic ciguatera (CC), a widespread, multisymptom, multisystem, chronic illness that can last tens of years 9d7e9ecaed
