33-centimeter band The band The 33-centimeter or 900 MHz band is a portion of the UHF radio spectrum internationally allocated to amateur radio on a secondary basis. It ranges from 902 to 928 MHz and is unique to ITU Region 2 (Americas). It is primarily used for very local communications as opposed to bands lower in frequency. Amateur stations must accept harmful interference caused by ISM users but may receive protection from unlicensed devices. However, very high antennas with high gain have shown 33 centimeters can provide good long-range communications almost equal to systems on lower frequencies such as the 70 centimeter band. The ITU amateur radio allocation is from 430 to 440 MHz; however, some countries, such as the United States, allocate hams 420 to 450 MHz. 70 centimeters is very close to the third harmonic of 2 meters, which allows sufficiently broadband 2-meter antennas to be used for 70 centimeters. Amateurs usually use the band for FM or digital voice communications through repeaters (useful for emergency communications), as well as narrow band modes (analog and digital) for long-distance communications (called "DX", including Moon bounce). The band is also popular for Amateur Satellite Service. Due to its size, it's the lowest frequency ham band which can support amateur television transmissions in the USA.
