Although DNA recovered from blood-feeding insects such as bedbugs (*Cimex lectularius*) has not been widely used in criminal casework, ongoing research has shown its potential to identify individuals from residual blood meals. Agelenopsis aperta It is found in dry and arid regions across the southern United States and into northwestern Mexico. They often hunt for their prey at night. It constructs the characteristic funnel-shaped webs in crevices where the funnel will fit, where they wait in the tube for prey which they can run after using their long legs. However, there have been a few cases of bites from Agelenopsis aperta, also known as the desert grass spider or funnel-web spider, is a species of spider belonging to the family Agelenidae and the genus Agelenopsis. Desert grass spiders can withstand very low temperatures even though they do not cold harden. Their body is about 13-18 mm long and they have relatively long legs in order to run after their prey. Bites from desert grass spiders are typically harmless and therefore not medically significant

== Plot == In 1758, Carl Linnaeus described the species in the tenth edition of his Systema Naturae, giving the name Scolopendra coleoptrata, writing that it has a "coleopterated thorax" (similar to a coleopter). In 1801, Jean-Baptiste Lamarck separated Scutigera from Scolopendra, calling this species Scutigera coleoptrata.
