Most commonly, oil platforms engage in activities on the continental shelf, though they can also be used in lakes, inshore waters, and inland seas. In March 1974, OAPEC lifted the embargo, but the price of oil had risen by nearly 300%: from US\$3 per barrel (\$19/m³) to nearly US\$12 per barrel (\$75/m³) globally. Prices in the United States were significantly higher than the global average. After it was implemented, the embargo caused an oil crisis, or "shock", with many short- and long-term effects on the global economy as well as on global politics.
