Taste Sweetness The gustatory system or sense of taste is the sensory system that is partially responsible for the perception of taste. The gustatory cortex is responsible for the perception of taste. Humans have taste receptors on taste buds and other areas, including the upper surface of the tongue and the epiglottis. Food addiction A food addiction or eating addiction is any behavioral addiction characterized primarily by the compulsive consumption of palatable and hyperpalatable food items, and potentially also sugar-sweetened beverages (SSBs). Those with eating addictions often overconsume such foods despite the adverse consequences (such as excess weight gain, diabetes, and heart disease) associated with their overconsumption. is craving food despite being full. Such foods often have high sugar, fat, and salt contents (HFSS), and markedly activate the reward system in humans and other animals. Pica (disorder) It is classified as an eating disorder but can also be the result of an existing mental disorder. The term was drawn directly from the Latin word for the Eurasian magpie, a bird subject to much folklore regarding its opportunistic feeding behaviors. Pica (/ˈpaɪkə/ PY-kə) is the psychologically compulsive craving or consumption of objects that are not normally intended to be consumed. The ingested or craved substance may be biological, natural, or manmade. The tongue is covered with thousands of small bumps called papillae, which are visible to the naked eye. Within each papilla are hundreds of taste buds. The exceptions to this are the filiform papillae, which do not contain taste buds. There are between 2000 and 5000 taste buds that are located on the back and front of the tongue. Others are located on the roof, sides and back of the mouth, and in the throat. Each taste bud contains 50 to 100 taste receptor cells. d5265731d9 The drug creates quick effects when smoked. Crack cocaine takes five to ten seconds before symptoms are shown. Short-term effects of the drug include euphoria, hyper-focus, sociability, cardiovascular hypertension, dilated pupils, hyperthermia, vertigo, tremors, and restlessness. Repeated use can lead to respiratory failure, seizures, CNS depression, and cardiomyopathy. The DSM-5-TR grades Addiction is a neuropsychological disorder characterized by a persistent and intense urge to use a drug or engage in a behavior that produces an immediate psychological reward, despite substantial harm and other negative consequences. It is therefore understood as a brain

disorder arising from a complex mix of psychosocial and neurobiological factors. These changes underlie both the intense drive to use a substance and the reduced capacity to control that urge. ordinary pleasures are muted, and reduced prefrontal cortex control leaves craving poorly restrained. In addition to sugars like sucrose, many other chemical compounds are sweet, including aldehydes, ketones, and sugar alcohols. Such non-sugar sweeteners include saccharin, aspartame, sucralose and stevia. Research Sweetness is a basic taste most

commonly perceived when eating foods rich in sugar. Some are sweet at very low concentrations, allowing their use as non-caloric sugar substitutes. Sweet tastes are generally regarded as pleasurable. Other compounds, such as miraculin, may alter perception of sweetness itself
