== Causes of shin-bang == Usually starting in a single limb, CRPS often first manifests as pain, swelling, limited range of motion or partial paralysis, or changes to the skin and bones. It may initially affect one limb and then spread throughout the body; 35% of affected individuals report symptoms throughout the body. Two types are thought to exist: CRPS type 1 (previously referred to as reflex sympathetic dystrophy) and CRPS type 2 (previously referred to as causalgia). It is possible to have both types.
