PL/SQL includes procedural language elements such as conditions and loops, and can handle exceptions (run-time errors). It allows the declaration of constants and variables, procedures, functions, packages, types and variables of those types, and triggers. Arrays are supported involving the use of PL/SQL collections. Implementations from version 8 of Oracle Database onwards have included features associated with object-orientation. One can create PL/SQL units such as procedures, functions, packages, types, and triggers, which are stored in the database for reuse by applications that use any of the Oracle Database programmatic interfaces.

Humans have just two... Parameter passing is defined by a programming language. Evaluation strategy defines the semantics for how parameters can be declared and how arguments are passed to a function. Generally, with call by value, a parameter acts like a new, local variable initialized to the value of the argument. If the argument is a variable, the function cannot modify the argument state because the parameter is a copy. With call by reference, which requires the argument to be a variable, the parameter is an alias of the argument. First-class functions are a necessity for the functional programming style, in which the use of higher-order functions is a standard practice. A simple example of a higher-ordered function is the map function, which takes, as its arguments, a function and a list, and returns the list formed by applying the function to each member of the list. For a language to support map, it must support

First-class function The term was coined by Christopher Strachey in the context of "functions as first-class citizens" in the mid-1960s. Some programming language In computer science, a programming language is said to have first-class functions if it treats functions as first-class citizens. Some programming language theorists require support for anonymous functions (function literals) as well. In languages with first-class functions, the names of functions do not have any special status; they are treated like ordinary variables with a function type. functions, returning them as the values from other functions, and assigning them to variables or storing them in data structures. Uses for stored procedures include data-validation (integrated into the database) or access-control mechanisms. Furthermore, stored procedures can consolidate and centralize logic that was originally implemented in applications. To save time and memory, extensive or complex processing that requires execution of several SQL statements can be saved into stored procedures, and all applications call the procedures. Closure (computer programming) metaphor for the difference between FUNCTION and QUOTE in LISP is to think of QUOTE as a porous or an open covering of the function since free variables In programming languages, a closure, also lexical closure or function closure, is a technique for implementing lexically scoped name binding in a language with first-class functions. The environment is a mapping associating each free variable of the function (variables that are used locally, but defined in an enclosing scope) with the value or reference to which the name was bound when the closure was created. Operationally, a closure is a record storing a function together with an environment. Unlike a plain function, a closure allows the function to access those captured variables through the closure's copies of their values or references, even when the function is invoked outside their scope 7ba9d9202b

They require an amount of storage space only fractionally greater than the total space required for the data or records themselves. Hashing is a way to access data quickly and efficiently. Unlike lists or trees, it provides near-constant access time. It also uses much less storage than trying to store all possible keys directly, especially when keys are large or variable
