== Overview == 9dd104b97c Postin (Lys-Pro-Pro-Arg) is the N-terminal tetrapeptide of cystatin C and an antagonist of tuftsin. 9dd104b97c Tuftsin (L-threonyl-L-lysyl-L-prolyl-L-arginine) is a peptide related primarily to the immune system function. 9dd104b97c == Medical uses == 9dd104b97c In 1916, Michel Weinberg and Pierre Séguin isolated this bacterium from patients with gas gangrene and called it *Bacillus histolyticus*. They discovered this bacterium was pathogenic for guinea pigs, mice, and rabbits, but less so for rats. Intramuscular injection of culture caused extensive local tissue destruction, extrusion of a hemorrhagic muscle pulp, splitting of the skin, denudation of the bone, and sometimes autoamputation. In 1922, Heller renamed the bacterium *Weinbergillus histolyticus*, and a year later Bergey, Harrison, et al. reclassified it as *Clostridium histolyticum*. In 2016, Lawson and Rainey recombined it as *Hathewayia histolytica*. 9dd104b97c

Hathewayia histolytica Collagenases are zinc metalloproteases that cleave collagen and gelatin into small fragments. The seven collagenases are alpha, beta *Hathewayia histolytica* (formerly *Clostridium histolyticum*) is a species of bacteria found in feces and the soil. H. seven collagenases. It is a motile, gram-positive, aerotolerant anaerobe. *histolytica* is pathogenic in many species, including guinea pigs, mice, and rabbits, and humans. *histolytica* has been shown to cause gas gangrene, often in association with other bacteria species. Endomorphin-1 (H-Tyr-Pro-Trp-Phe-NH₂) and endomorphin-2 (H-Tyr-Pro-Phe-Phe-NH₂) are peptide amides with the highest known affinity and specificity for the μ opioid receptor. 9dd104b97c It is available as a generic medication. 9dd104b97c Rigin (glycyl-L-glutamyl-L-prolyl-L-arginine) is a tetrapeptide with functions similar to those of tuftsin. 9dd104b97c In 1933 Vincenzo Bisceglie made the first attempt to encapsulate cells in polymer membranes. He demonstrated that tumor cells in a polymer structure transplanted into pig abdominal cavity remained viable for a long period without being rejected by the immune system. 9dd104b97c Penicillamine was approved for medical use in the United States in 1970. Pirfenidone "Effects of pirfenidone on proliferation, migration, and collagen contraction of human Tenon's fibroblasts in Pirfenidone, sold under the brand name Esbriet among others, is a medication used for the treatment of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis. It works by reducing lung fibrosis through

It is used as a chelating agent: 9dd104b97c In the European Union, pirfenidone is indicated for the treatment of mild-to-moderate idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis. It was approved by the European Medicines Agency in 2011. In October 2008, it was approved for use in Japan, in India in 2010, and in China in 2011 (commercial launch in 2014). In October 2014, it was approved for medical use in the United States. A tablet version was approved for use in the United States in January 2017. 9dd104b97c The compound appears as a white hygroscopic powder. Very soluble in water and easily soluble in alcohol, it is practically insoluble in dichloromethane and poorly soluble in isopropyl alcohol. Cell encapsulation Cell microencapsulation technology involves immobilization of cells within a polymeric semi-permeable membrane. nature of the cellulose sulphate capsules. These studies show the promising Cell encapsulation is a possible solution to graft rejection in tissue engineering applications. essential for cell metabolism and the outward diffusion of waste products and therapeutic proteins. In one patient the capsules were in place for almost 2 years with no side effects. At the same time, the semi-permeable nature of the membrane prevents immune cells and antibodies from destroying the encapsulated cells, regarding them as foreign invaders. It permits the bidirectional diffusion of molecules such as the influx of oxygen, nutrients, growth factors etc. On the other hand, single-cell nanoencapsulation (SCNE) involves the formation of nanometric shells around individual living cells 9dd104b97c

Glaucoma such as the Ologen collagen matrix, which has been clinically shown to increase the success rates of surgical treatment. Glaucoma may cause vision loss if left untreated. It is associated with old age, a family history of glaucoma, and certain medical conditions or the use of some medications. The word glaucoma comes from the Ancient Greek word γλαυκός (glaukós), meaning 'gleaming, blue-green, gray'. It has been called the "silent thief of sight" because the loss of vision usually occurs slowly over a long period of time. Collagen matrix prevents scarring Glaucoma is a group of eye diseases that can lead to damage of the optic nerve, which transmits visual information from the eye to the brain. A major risk factor for glaucoma is increased pressure within the eye, known as intraocular pressure (IOP) 9dd104b97c

Common side effects include rash, loss of appetite, nausea, diarrhea, and Penicillamine, sold under the brand name of Cuprimine among others, is a medication primarily used for the treatment of Wilson's disease. Joint Other joints such as sutures between the bones of the skull permit very little movement (only during birth) in order to protect the brain and the sense organs. Some joints, such as the knee, elbow, and shoulder, are self-lubricating, almost frictionless, and are able to withstand compression and maintain heavy loads while still executing smooth and precise movements. Joints are classified both structurally and functionally. The connection between a tooth and the jawbone is also called a joint, and is described as a fibrous joint known as a gomphosis. They are constructed to allow for different degrees and types of movement. There are two types: A joint or articulation (or articular surface) is the connection made between bones, ossicles, or other hard structures in the body which link an animal's skeletal system into a functional whole. fibrous joint – joined by dense regular connective tissue that is rich in collagen fibers cartilaginous joint – joined by cartilage 9dd104b97c

Of the different types of glaucoma, the most common are called open-angle glaucoma and closed-angle glaucoma. Inside the eye, a liquid called aqueous humor, which is produced by the ciliary body, helps to maintain shape and provides nutrients. The aqueous humor normally drains through the trabecular meshwork. In open-angle glaucoma, the drainage is impeded, causing the build up of aqueous to accumulate in the anterior chamber causing the pressure inside the eye to increase. The posture can occur in dentists, surgeons, and hairdressers, or people who spend time on electronic devices. Forward head posture (FHP) is an excessively kyphotic (hunched) thoracic spine. It is clinically recognized as a form of repetitive strain injury 9dd104b97c

Tetrapeptide By utilizing time-lapse cinematography A tetrapeptide is a peptide, classified as an oligopeptide, since it only consists of four amino acids joined by peptide bonds. matrix component including; fibronectin, type I collagen, type II collagen, laminin, and lens capsule basement membrane. Present in nature are both linear and cyclic tetrapeptides (CTPs), the latter of which mimics protein reverse turns which are often present on the surface of proteins and druggable targets. Tetrapeptides may be cyclized by a fourth peptide bond or other covalent bonds. Many tetrapeptides are pharmacologically active, often showing affinity and specificity for a variety of receptors in protein-protein signaling 9dd104b97c
