Open-crotch pants After re-engineering its diapers to be softer and selling them Open-crotch pants (simplified Chinese: 开裆裤; traditional Chinese: 開裆褲; pinyin: kāidāngkù), also known as open-crotch trousers or split pants, are worn by toddlers throughout mainland China. The sight of the partially exposed buttocks of kaidangku-clad children in public places frequently astonishes foreign visitors, who often photograph them. They have been described as being "as much a sign of China as Chairman Mao's portrait looming over Tiananmen Square". The child simply squats, or is held by the parent, eliminating the need for diapers. Like all other amino acids, aspartic acid contains an amino group and a carboxylic acid. Its  $\alpha$ -amino group is in the protonated  $-\text{NH}_3^+$  form under physiological conditions, while its  $\alpha$ -carboxylic acid group is deprotonated  $-\text{COO}^-$  under physiological conditions. Aspartic acid has an acidic side chain ( $\text{CH}_2\text{COOH}$ ) which reacts with other amino acids, enzymes and proteins in the body. Under physiological conditions (pH 7.4) in proteins the side chain usually occurs as the negatively charged aspartate form,  $-\text{COO}^-$ .
