

What Is The Excretory System

They are classified along with arthropods, tardigrades and other moulting animals in the clade Ecdysozoa. Unlike the flatworms, nematodes have a tubular digestive system, with openings at both ends. With the advent of phylogenetics, *Xenoturbella* and Acoelomorpha were found to be sister groups and only distantly related to flatworms. Initially, this phylum was considered to be a member of the deuterostomes, but later transcriptome analyses have suggested that the phylum Xenacoelomorpha is a sister group to all the other bilateria. In this model, Xenacoelomorpha are neither protostomes nor deuterostomes, and the protostomes and deuterostomes together make up a new clade that has been named Nephrozoa. This makes Xenacoelomorpha the basalmost bilaterian clade....

Bulbourethral gland The paired glands are found adjacent to the urethra just below the prostate. 5 cm long and opens into the bulbar urethra at the base The bulbourethral glands or Cowper's glands (named after the English anatomist William Cowper KOO-pər) are two small exocrine and accessory glands in the reproductive system of many male mammals. The bulbourethral glands are responsible for producing a pre-ejaculate fluid called Cowper's fluid (known colloquially as pre-cum), which is secreted during sexual arousal, neutralizing the acidity of the urethra in preparation for the passage of sperm cells. They are homologous to Bartholin's glands in females. with the ducts of other lobules to form a single excretory duct. This duct is approximately 2 38896d27ca

Urinary system The female and male urinary system are very similar, differing only in the length of the urethra, which transports urine from the bladder through the penis or vulva during urination. In humans and placental mammals, it consists of the kidneys, ureters, bladder, and the urethra. Most species of placental mammals have bulbourethral glands. They are the only accessory reproductive glands in male monotremes. Placental mammals usually have one pair of bulbourethral glands, while male marsupials have 1–3 pairs. Of all domesticated animals, they are absent only in dogs. 38896d27ca

Nematode Most species are free-living, feeding on microorganisms, but many are parasitic. In Secernentia there is an excretory canal system The nematodes (NEM-ə-tohdz, NEE-mə-), roundworms or eelworms constitute the phylum Nematoda (Ancient Greek: Νηματώδη; Latin: Nematoda). Parasitic worms (helminths) are the cause of soil-transmitted helminthiasis. They are enclosed by transverse fibers of the sphincter urethrae membranaceae muscle. 38896d27ca Haemolymph is the analogue of blood for most arthropods. An arthropod has an open circulatory system, with a body cavity called a haemocoel through which haemolymph circulates to the interior organs. Like their exteriors, the internal organs of arthropods are generally built of repeated segments. They have ladder-like nervous

systems, with paired ventral nerve cords running through all segments and forming paired ganglia in each segment. Their heads are formed by fusion of varying numbers of segments, and their brains are formed by fusion of the ganglia of these segments and encircle the esophagus. The respiratory and excretory systems of arthropods vary, depending as much on their environment as on the subphylum to which they belong. 38896d27ca

Xenacoelomorpha This new phylum was named in February 2011 and suggested based on morphological synapomorphies (physical appearances shared by the animals in the clade), which was then confirmed by phylogenomic analyses of molecular data (similarities in the DNA of the animals within the clade). Also, an excretory system is absent, yet all genes related to the excretory system are present except for *Osr*, which is essential for the development. **Xenacoelomorpha** () is a small phylum of bilaterian invertebrate animals, consisting of two sister groups: acoelomorphs and xenoturbellids 38896d27ca

The body wall displays several furrows: on the circumference, on the side, and two deep, longitudinal, dorsal ones. The mouth is oriented ventrally, anterior to the ring furrow. The live specimen exhibits an inconspicuous epidermal ventral glandular network. 38896d27ca *X. hollandorum* shares morphological similarities with other species of the genus *Xenoturbella* and is known for lacking a respiratory, circulatory, and excretory system. 38896d27ca Plain CT urography (without contrast) is used to evaluate stone diseases, calcifications within kidneys, density of renal masses and presence of any bleeding before contrast is given. Then iodinated contrast is given intravenously to evaluate kidney tumours (if any) and urinary tract. CT scan is then taken at 30 to 70 seconds (when the contrast reaches the renal cortex and renal medulla) to evaluate the perfusion and vascularity of the kidneys. CT scan taken at 90 to 180 seconds (when the contrast perfused the whole kidney) to evaluate the characteristics of kidney masses. The contrast starts to drain into the collecting system of the kidneys at 3 minutes after injection and the whole collecting system is well distended with contrast at 8 to 10 minutes.
