Hammett equation acids with substituents that have unshared electron pairs such as $-OH$ and $-OCH_3$, as these substituents interact strongly with the benzene ring. This equation was developed and published by Louis Plack Hammett in 1937 as a follow-up to qualitative observations in his 1935 publication. [non-primary In organic chemistry, the Hammett equation describes a linear free-energy relationship relating reaction rates and equilibrium constants for many reactions involving benzoic acid derivatives with meta- and para-substituents to each other with just two parameters: a substituent constant and a reaction constant 177668ed39

The first neuraminidase Inhibitors (NAIs) were synthesized in the 1960s by Edmond et al., through an attempt to understand the catalytic mechanism of the neuraminidase enzyme. They discovered that N-substituted oxamic acids had enzyme inhibitory properties. Then it was found that the synthetic compound 2-deoxy-2,3-didehydro-N-acetylneuraminic acid (Neu5Ac2en or DANA) which is an analogue of N-acetylneuraminic acid (Neu5Ac), inhibits the release of virus progeny in tissue culture but no antiviral activity in animals was detected. 177668ed39

Avenanthramide It was later found that three avenanthramides were the open-ring amides of avenaluminos I, II, and III, which were previously reported as oat phytoalexins by Mayama and co-workers. Oat kernel extracts with standardized levels of avenanthramides are used for skin, hair, baby, and sun care products. rapae), and in fungus-infected carnation (*Dianthus caryophyllus*). The name avenanthramides was coined by Collins when he reported the presence of these compounds in oat kernels. oats responsible for the anti-inflammatory effect until more attention was paid to avenanthramides, which were first isolated and characterized in the Avenanthramides (anthranilic acid amides, formerly called "avenaluminos") are a group of phenolic alkaloids found mainly in oats (*Avena sativa*), but also present in white cabbage butterfly eggs (*Pieris brassicae* and P. A number of studies demonstrate that these natural products have anti-inflammatory, antioxidant, anti-itch, anti-irritant, and antiatherogenic activities 177668ed39

Discovery and development of neuraminidase inhibitors that shows inhibitory activity close to zanamivir. Laninamivir is designed by replacing C7 hydroxy moiety with small lipophilic group, $-OCH_3$, which resulted Neuraminidase inhibitors inhibit enzymatic activity of the enzyme neuraminidase (sialidase). These types of inhibitors have been introduced as anti-influenza drugs as they prevent the virus from exiting infected cells and thus stop further spreading of the virus. Neuraminidase inhibitors for human neuraminidase (hNEU) have the potential to be useful drugs as the enzyme plays a role in several signaling pathways in cells and is implicated in diseases such as diabetes and cancer 177668ed39

Gliotoxin It is the most prominent member of the epipolythiopiperazines, a large class of natural products featuring a diketopiperazine with di- or polysulfide linkage. Gliotoxin was originally isolated from *Gliocladium fimbriatum*, and was named accordingly. It is an epipolythiodioxopiperazine metabolite that is one of the most abundantly produced metabolites in human invasive Aspergillosis (IA). These highly bioactive compounds have been the subject of numerous studies aimed at new therapeutics. followed by lithium chloride treatment in DMF and hydrolysis ($NaOCH_3/CH_3OH-CH_2Cl_2$ /room temperature) give the chloride 6 at a 95% overall yield Gliotoxin is a sulfur-containing mycotoxin that belongs to a class of naturally occurring 2,5-diketopiperazines produced by several species of fungi, especially those of marine origin 177668ed39

In the early 1990s, the determination of biological crystal structure of influenza virus surface protein led to the discovery of the active site and provided the opportunities... 177668ed39 Even though direct bonding as a wafer bonding technique is able to process nearly all materials, silicon is the most established material up to now. It is important to understand, that the equilibrium constants in this relationship come from thermodynamics but the reaction rate constants come from chemical kinetics, and neither discipline predicts such relationship. Instead, it was introduced by Hammett empirically. Hammett equation belongs to a larger set of correlations between the rate of a chemical reaction and its driving force. 177668ed39 The compound is produced by human pathogens such as *Aspergillus fumigatus*, and also by species of *Trichoderma* and *Penicillium*. Gliotoxin has also been reported from yeasts of the genus *Candida*, but results from other studies have cast doubt on the production of this metabolite by *Candida* fungi. Gliotoxin is not produced by nonpathogenic *A. fischeri* although *A. fischeri* contains a gene cluster that is homologous to the gliotoxin gene cluster found in the pathogenic *A. fumigatus*. Gliotoxin contributes... 177668ed39 In his book *PiHKAL* (Phenethylamines I Have Known and Loved) and other publications, Alexander Shulgin lists desoxy's dose as 40 to 120 mg orally and its duration as 6 to 8 hours. Desoxy (psychedelic) It is the analogue of mescaline in which the methoxy group at the 4 position has been replaced with a methyl group, hence an oxygen has been removed and the name "desoxy". The drug is also a positional isomer of 2C-D (4-Me-2,5-DMPA). Substitution of 4-OCH₃ group in mescaline with CH₃ imparted rage producing properties to the compound Desoxy, or DESOXY, also known as 4-desoxymescaline, 4-methylmescaline, or 4-methyl-3,5-dimethoxyphenethylamine (4-Me-3,5-DMPA), is a psychedelic drug of the phenethylamine and desoxyscaline families related to mescaline (3,4,5-trimethoxyphenethylamine). 1007/978-3-0348-7062-7_1. Discovery and development of proton pump inhibitors A literature search showed that some substituted mercapto-benzimidazoles had no effect on iodine uptake and introduction of such Proton pump inhibitors (PPIs) block the gastric hydrogen potassium ATPase (H^+/K^+ ATPase) and inhibit gastric acid

Literature from anaesthetic screenings led attention to the potential antiviral compound pyridylthioacetamide which after further examination pointed the focus on an anti-secretory compound with unknown mechanisms of action called timoprazole. Timoprazole is a pyridylmethylsulfinyl benzimidazole and appealed due to its simple chemical structure and its surprisingly high level of anti-secretory activity. 177668ed39

Henk Buck biochemical dynamics of cAMP. From 1988 to 1991 he was Dean of the Chemical Faculty. Because there was no chair for Theoretical Chemistry and Biochemistry he gave lectures in organic chemistry, physical organic chemistry, theoretical organic chemistry, biochemistry and biotechnology. In 1970 he was appointed professor of Physical Organic Chemistry and Organic Chemistry at the University of Technology in Eindhoven. He got a lectorship at the university in Theoretical Organic Chemistry in 1964. Under his supervision 43 chemical engineers obtained their PhD. He was born in Dordrecht on 7 February 1930. For his research he received the Golden Medal of the Royal Netherlands Chemical Society in 1967. The end of his career came prematurely because of a publication in Science in 1990 regarding a possible cure for cancer that had to be retracted. For his scientific contributions he became a member of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences in 1979. Buck studied at the University of Leiden where he received his PhD in 1959. Because of the importance of shielding, the OCH₃ group was introduced as substitute for O⁻ in the study of intermediates for Henk Buck (7 February 1930 – 27 November 2023) was a Dutch organic chemist. During his scientific career he published more than 300 scientific papers spread over a large area of the chemical field 177668ed39

It acts as a non-selective serotonin receptor agonist, including of the serotonin 5-HT_{1A} and 5-HT_{2A} receptors among others. Uniquely among most tryptamines, the drug has been found to produce serotonergic neurotoxicity and associated cognitive deficits in rodents reminiscent of but distinct from those observed with MDMA.
