The purple violet is a low-growing perennial herbaceous plant up to 20 cm (8 in) tall. This species was first described by Ferdinand von Mueller as *Vitex leichhardtii* in 1862, based on material collected near Myall Creek by Ludwig Leichhardt, and near the Clarence River by Dr. Hermann Beckler. In 1870 George Bentham reassigned it to the genus *Gmelina* in his *Flora Australiensis*. The genus name honours German botanist Johann Georg Gmelin, while the species name honours Leichhardt, who explored and collected specimens from the country's east and north. Space capsule Sub-orbital capsules, such as Blue Origin's New Shepard A space capsule is a spacecraft designed to transport cargo, scientific experiments, and/or astronauts to and from space. Reentry capsules are distinguished from other spacecraft by the ability to survive atmospheric reentry and return a payload to

the Earth's surface from orbit or sub-orbit, and are distinguished from other types of recoverable spacecraft (eg. spaceplanes) by their blunt shape, not having wings. examples of crewed space capsules include the orbital Soyuz, Shenzhou, Dragon 2 and NASA's Orion. The design, a shield containing the Blue Peter ship logo, was designed by Tony Hart.
