Preclinical imaging Micro-ultrasound systems are portable, do not require any dedicated facilities, and is extremely cost-effective compared to other systems. Imaging modalities have long been crucial to the researcher in observing changes, either at the organ, tissue, cell, or molecular level, in animals responding to physiological or environmental changes.
