Heat wave This would be the case if the warm temperatures are outside the normal climate pattern for that area. The main difficulties with this broad definition emerge when one must quantify what the 'normal' temperature state is, and what the spatial extent of the event may or must be. Temperatures that humans from a hotter climate consider normal can be regarded as a heat wave in a cooler area. Urushiol-induced contact dermatitis The name is derived from the Japanese word for the sap of the Chinese lacquer tree, urushi. The rash typically persists one to two weeks, but in some cases may last up to five weeks. Urushiol primarily Urushiol-induced contact dermatitis (also called Toxicodendron dermatitis or Rhus dermatitis) is a type of allergic contact dermatitis caused by the oil urushiol found in various plants, most notably sumac family species of the genus Toxicodendron: poison ivy, poison oak, poison sumac, and the Chinese lacquer tree. several times, before they develop a rash.
