

What's The Difference Between White Eggs And Brown Eggs

Egging is the prehistoric practice of foraging wild-bird eggs. Gull egging is practiced (to varying degrees) in several subarctic regions, including in Canada, Alaska, Greenland, Iceland, the Faroe Islands, Norway, Åland, Russia (by indigenous minorities of the north), and the British Isles. Gull eggs are collected from a number of species in the family Laridae, including the black-headed gull, glaucous gull, glaucous-winged gull, the great black-backed gull, Heermann's gull, the various subspecies of herring gull, the laughing gull, the lesser black-backed gull, Sabine... Besides boiling water immersion, there are a few different methods to make boiled eggs. Eggs can also be cooked below the boiling temperature, i.e. coddling, or they can be steamed. The egg timer was named for commonly being used to time the boiling of eggs. Eggs have a long history of use as food, following the history of the domestic chicken, and recipes that include boiled eggs are found in the first known cookbook, *De re coquinaria*, in which at least one recipe calls for the use of preserved boiled eggs. Alexander Pope recommended a method of cooking eggs over the embers or ashes of an open fire.
