The original Voskhod had been designed to carry two cosmonauts, but Soviet politicians pushed the Soviet space program into squeezing three cosmonauts into Voskhod 1. The only other space flight in the short Voskhod program, Voskhod 2, carried two suited cosmonauts – of necessity, because it was the flight on which Alexei Leonov made the world's first walk in space. 602469122f == Cosmonauts == 602469122f The criteria for what constitutes human spaceflight vary. Until the 21st century, human spaceflight programs were sponsored exclusively by governments, through either the military or civilian space agencies. With the launch of the privately funded SpaceShipOne in 2004, a new category of human spaceflight programs – commercial human spaceflight – arrived. By the end of 2022, three countries (Soviet Union/Russia, United States and China) and one private company (SpaceX) had successfully launched humans to Earth orbit, and two private companies (Scaled

Composites and Blue Origin) had launched humans on a suborbital trajectory. 602469122f By November 1961, the Soviet Union had launched Yuri Gagarin and Gherman Titov into orbit during the Vostok 1 and Vostok 2 crewed orbital flights while the United States had managed only suborbital ones. At that time NASA was still debating placing a chimpanzee in orbit as part of the Mercury-Atlas subprogram, with NASA headquarters questioning the wisdom of the Manned Spacecraft Center launching another uncrewed Mercury mission. 602469122f The original mission plan was complex, involving a rendezvous with Soyuz 2 and an exchange of crew members before returning to Earth. However, the launch of Soyuz 2 was called off due to thunderstorms. 602469122f

the test flight of the Mercury-Redstone Launch Vehicle just prior to the first crewed American space mission in Project Mercury. MR-1A had climbed to its programmed apogee of about 130 miles (210 km) and landed 235 miles (378 km) downrange. Voskhod 1 Flown by cosmonauts Vladimir Komarov, Konstantin Feoktistov, and Boris Yegorov, it launched 12 October 1964, and returned on the 13th. It also set a crewed spacecraft altitude record of 336 km (209 mi). A solid-fuel braking rocket was also added to the space capsule's parachute lines to provide for Voskhod 1 (Russian: Восток-1, lit. Voskhod 1 was the first human spaceflight to carry more than one crewman into orbit, the first flight without the use of spacesuits, and the first to carry either an engineer or a physician into outer space. cosmonauts also had to go on a diet to fit in their couches. Couch was indicted on four counts of intoxication manslaughter for recklessly driving under the influence. In December 2013, Judge Jean Hudson Boyd sentenced Couch to ten years of probation, subsequently ordering him to undergo therapy at a long term inpatient facility. Before sentencing, Couch's attorneys had argued that Couch had "influenza" and needed rehabilitation instead of prison, arguing that Couch had no understanding of boundaries as his affluent parents had never given him any. Ethan Couch Two passengers in Couch's pickup truck were critically injured, one of whom was completely paralyzed. The collision killed four people and injured nine others. Couch, while intoxicated and under the influence of drugs, was driving on a restricted license and speeding in a residential area when he lost control of his vehicle, which slammed into a group of people assisting another driver with a disabled car. Soyuz 1 The flight was plagued with technical issues, and Komarov was killed when the descent module crashed into the ground due to a parachute failure. This was the first in-flight fatality in the history of spaceflight. Launched into orbit on 23 April 1967 carrying cosmonaut colonel Vladimir Komarov, Soyuz 1 was the first crewed flight of the Soyuz spacecraft. at last ended, the rescuers were able to dig through the rubble to find Komarov strapped into the center couch; his body had turned into charred clothing Soyuz 1 (Russian: Союз 1, lit. Lawnchair Larry flight The aircraft rose to an altitude of about 16,000 feet (4,900 m), drifted from the point of liftoff in the San Pedro neighborhood of Los Angeles, California, and entered controlled airspace near Long Beach Airport. 3+1/2 miles (6 km) NNW of North Powder, Oregon, about 30 miles (50 km) from the Idaho border. The flight attracted worldwide media attention and inspired a movie (Danny Deckchair), a musical, and numerous imitators. Traveling an average of 22 mph (35 km/h), Couch used plastic On July 2, 1982, Larry Walters (April 19, 1949 – October 6, 1993) made a 45-minute flight in a homemade aerostat made of an ordinary lawn chair and 42 helium-filled weather balloons.
