It is used to increase urine citrate levels - this prevents calcium oxalate stones by binding to calcium and inhibiting its binding to oxalate

If PVCs are frequent or troublesome, medication (beta blockers or certain calcium channel blockers) may be used. Very frequent PVCs in people with dilated cardiomyopathy may be treated with radiofrequency ablation. Common side effects include constipation and nausea. When taken by mouth high blood calcium is uncommon. Calcium supplements, unlike calcium from dietary sources, appear to increase the risk of kidney stones. Adults generally require about a gram of calcium a day. Calcium is particularly important for bones, muscles, and nerves. == Available forms == In plants, magnesium is necessary for synthesis of chlorophyll and photosynthesis. Magnesium sulfate is usually encountered in the form of a hydrate  $\text{MgSO}_4 \cdot n\text{H}_2\text{O}$ , for various values of  $n$  between 1 and 11. The most common is the heptahydrate  $\text{MgSO}_4 \cdot 7\text{H}_2\text{O}$ , known as Epsom salt, which is a household chemical with many traditional uses, including bath salts. Causes include low dietary intake, alcoholism, diarrhea, increased urinary loss, and poor absorption from the intestines. Some medications may also cause low magnesium, including proton pump inhibitors (PPIs) and furosemide. The diagnosis is typically based on finding low blood magnesium

It is less dense than aluminium and is used primarily as a component in strong and lightweight alloys that contain aluminium. The metal is obtained mainly by electrolysis of magnesium salts obtained from brine. It is a shiny gray metal having a low density, low melting point, and high chemical reactivity. Treatment is with magnesium either by mouth or intravenously. For those with severe symptoms, intravenous magnesium sulfate may be used. Associated low potassium or low calcium should also be treated. The condition is relatively common among people in hospitals. bf232da59f

Calcium supplement Supplementation is generally only required when there is not enough calcium in the diet. By mouth they are used to treat and prevent low blood calcium, osteoporosis, and rickets. By injection into a vein they are used for low blood calcium that is resulting in muscle spasms and for high blood potassium or magnesium toxicity. Calcium citrate as a calcium

It is different from citric acid which is citrate bonded by hydrogen ions (or protons) making it acidic. Citric acid does not alkalinize urine as alkali citrate does. Alkali citrate replaces the protons with a non-acid positively charged ion like sodium, potassium or magnesium. bf232da59f

Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough they may pass out of the urinary tract through the urine stream. This imbalance causes tiny crystals to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones), in the upper urinary tract bf232da59f

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Gallium nitrate Gallium nitrate is also used to synthesize other gallium compounds. Gallium competes with magnesium in DNA binding, since its DNA affinity is 100 times higher than that of magnesium. It works by preventing the breakdown of bone through the inhibition of osteoclast activity, thus lowering the amount of free calcium in the blood. It is a drug used to treat symptomatic hypercalcemia secondary to cancer. Renal is Latin for "kidney", while nephro is the Greek equivalent. Lithiasis (Greek) and calculus (Latin; plural calculi) both mean stone. Hence, kidney stones are sometimes known as renal calculi or nephroliths, and the condition may be known as nephrolithiasis. bf232da59f

Mineral (nutrient) Some "minerals" are essential for life, but most are not. of compounds), such as calcium (calcium carbonate, calcium citrate) or magnesium (magnesium oxide), or iron (ferrous sulfate, iron bis-glycinate). The remaining minerals are called "trace elements". The generally accepted trace elements are iron, chlorine, cobalt, copper, zinc, manganese, molybdenum, iodine, selenium, and bromine; there is some evidence that there may be more. The five major minerals in the human body are calcium, phosphorus, potassium, sodium, and magnesium. The electrical events of the heart detected by the electrocardiogram (ECG) allow a PVC to be easily distinguished from a normal heart beat. However, very frequent PVCs can be symptomatic of an underlying heart condition (such as arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy). Furthermore, very frequent (over 20% of all heartbeats) PVCs are considered a risk factor for arrhythmia-induced cardiomyopathy, in which the heart muscle becomes less effective and symptoms of heart failure may develop. Ultrasound of the heart is therefore recommended in people with frequent PVCs. bf232da59f

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
