It is typically a foodborne illness, usually spread by eating food or drinking water contaminated with infected feces. Undercooked or raw shellfish are relatively common sources. It may also be spread through close contact with an infectious person. While children often do not have symptoms when infected, they are still able to infect others. After a single infection, a person is immune for the rest of their life. Diagnosis requires blood testing, as the symptoms are similar to those of a number of other diseases. It is one of five known hepatitis viruses: A, B, C, D, and E. 5d964fe297

Following a number of highly publicized incidents throughout the 1970s-1980s, preventing disease transmission through blood donation is addressed through a series of safeguards. Blood safety measures that limit this risk of disease transmission through blood donation are considered essential in upholding public trust in blood donation, and to avoid harm to blood recipients who are frequently vulnerable to severe disease. The World Health Organization recommends screening potential blood donors for signs and symptoms of disease and for activities that might put them at risk for infection, including mandatory testing of donated blood for relevant pathogens prior to transmission, sometimes with several different methodologies. Additional safeguards, such as leukoreduction and pathogen inactivation can be applied, and are frequently mandatory... 5d964fe297
