Culture of Brazil " There are marking differences between perceptions The culture of Brazil has been shaped by the amalgamation of diverse indigenous cultures, and the cultural fusion that took place among Indigenous communities, Portuguese colonists, and Africans, primarily during the Brazilian colonial period. In the late 19th and early 20th centuries, Brazil received a significant number of immigrants, primarily of Portuguese, Italian, Spanish, and German origin, which along with smaller numbers of Austrians, Dutch, French, Russians, Armenians, Arabs, Jews, Poles, Ukrainians, Swiss, Hungarians, Greeks, Chinese, Japanese and Koreans gave a relevant contribution to the formation of regional cultures in Brazil, and thus contributed to its current existence as a plural and racially diverse society. light-skinned Brazilians have long preferred to think of themselves as 'white';, whatever their parentage c02f2b7ce1

Khairuddin Nazrul (Malaysia) Brazil wanted to beat Timor-Leste by more goals than Portugal did because of goal difference. Brazil defeated Timor-Leste 76–0, setting a world record for largest win in an international futsal match. One of Brazil's players, Valdin, scored 20 goals, which is another record.
