Nitenpyram flea infestations in cats and dogs. It does so by binding irreversibly to the nicotinic acetylcholine receptor (nAChR) causing a stop of the flow of ions in the postsynaptic membrane of neurons leading to paralysis and death. Flea Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1⁄8 inch) long, are usually dark in color, and have bodies that are "flattened" sideways or narrow, enabling them to move through their hosts' fur or feathers. cats. The bites often appear in clusters or lines of two bites, and can remain itchy and inflamed for up to several weeks afterwards. Their claws keep them from being dislodged, and their mouthparts are adapted for piercing skin and sucking blood. They lack wings; their hind legs are extremely well adapted for jumping. Fleas can lead to Flea, the common name for the order Siphonaptera, includes 2,500 species of small flightless insects that live as external parasites of mammals and birds. Some species can leap 50 times their body length, a feat second only to jumps made by another group of insects, the superfamily of froghoppers. Fleas live by ingesting the blood of their hosts. Flea larvae are worm-like, with no limbs; they have chewing mouthparts and feed on organic debris left on their hosts' skin 71421f97e0
