COVID-19 testing It is used to assess disease prevalence, which aids the estimation of the infection fatality rate. This variation COVID-19 testing involves analyzing samples to assess the current or past presence of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19 and is responsible for the COVID-19 pandemic. Antibody tests (serology immunoassays) instead show whether someone once had the disease. Molecular tests for viral presence through its molecular components are used to diagnose individual cases and to allow public health authorities to trace and contain outbreaks. Nontreponemal tests for syphilis Nontreponemal tests are A nontreponemal test (NTT) is a blood test for diagnosis of infection with syphilis. These have mostly replaced the first nontreponemal test, the Wassermann test. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)-approved standard tests include the VDRL test (a slide test), the rapid plasma reagin (RPR) test (a card test), the unheated serum reagin (USR) test, and the toluidine red unheated serum test (TRUST). In contrast, treponemal tests look for antibodies that are a direct result of the infection thus, anti-treponeme IgG, IgM and to a lesser degree IgA.
