The neurotoxin prevents presynaptic release of acetylcholine from neuromuscular... 48da8065a6 The life cycle of T. leonina is fairly simple. Eggs are ingested and hatch in the small intestine. The juveniles then penetrate the mucosal lining of the small intestine. After growth and molt, they return to the intestinal lumen and mature. The adult female worm lays eggs which are passed in the feces of the animal. The... 48da8065a6 The prodromal symptoms are fever, headache, and myalgia, which can be severe, lasting as long as 24 hours. After 1-5 days, typically, these are followed by diarrhea (as many as 10 watery, frequently bloody, bowel movements per day) or dysentery, cramps, abdominal pain, and fever as high as 40 °C (104 °F). In most people, the illness lasts for 2-10 days. It is classified as invasive/inflammatory diarrhea, also described as bloody diarrhea or dysentery. 48da8065a6

Toxascaris leonina Infection occurs in the definitive host when the animal eats an infected rodent. While T. leonina include canids Toxascaris leonina is a common parasitic roundworm found in dogs, cats, foxes, and related host species. The definitive hosts of T. leonina is an ascarid nematode, a worldwide distributed helminth parasite which is in a division of eukaryotic parasites that, unlike external parasites such as lice and fleas, live inside their host. The definitive hosts of T. T. leonina include canids (dogs, foxes, etc.) and felines (cats), while the intermediate hosts are usually rodents, such as mice or rats. leonina can occur in either dogs or cats, it is far more frequent in cats. of eukaryotic parasites that, unlike external parasites such as lice and fleas, live inside their host 48da8065a6

== Life cycle == 48da8065a6 The adult worm is about 18 inches (46 cm) long. Gravid proglottids containing the worm's microscopic eggs are either passed in the definitive host's feces or may leave their host spontaneously and are then ingested by microscopic flea larvae (the intermediate hosts) in the surrounding environment. As in all members of family Dipylidiidae, proglottids of the adult worm have genital pores on both sides (hence the name double-pore tapeworm). Each side has a set of male and female reproductive organs. The uterus is paired with 16 to 20 radial branches each. The scolex has a retractable rostellum with four rows of hooks, along with the four suckers that all cyclophyllid cestodes have. 48da8065a6

Afoxolaner It is used to kill fleas and ticks in small animals. are indicated for the treatment and prevention of flea infestations, and the treatment and control of tick infestations in dogs and puppies (8 weeks of Afoxolaner is an insecticide and acaricide that belongs to the isoxazoline chemical compound group 48da8065a6

Fluralaner inhibits γ -aminobutyric acid (GABA)-gated chloride channels (GABAA receptors) and L-glutamate-gated chloride channels (GluCl_s). Potency of fluralaner is comparable to fipronil (a related GABA-antagonist insecticide and acaricide). 48da8065a6

Fluralaner approved it for the treatment and prevention of ticks and fleas on dogs in January 2015. For treating mites in chickens, a solution for use in drinking Fluralaner (INN), sold under the brand name Bravecto among others, is a systemic insecticide and acaricide that is administered orally or topically 48da8065a6

== Immune-mediated skin disorders == 48da8065a6 There are other diseases showing similar symptoms. For instance, abdominal pain and tenderness may be very localized, mimicking acute appendicitis. Furthermore, *Helicobacter pylori* is closely related to *Campylobacter* and causes peptic ulcer disease. 48da8065a6 Afoxolaner is a GABA receptor antagonist, which stops chloride transmission in nerves and muscles resulting in paralysis with the paralysis resulting in death for the insect. Afoxolaner is more selective for GABA receptors in insects than mammals making it safe to give to an animal in amounts that are still lethal to insects. 48da8065a6

== Adult morphology == 48da8065a6 Selectivity for insect over mammalian GABA-receptors has been demonstrated for other isoxazolines. The selectivity might be explained by the number of pharmacological differences that exist between GABA-gated chloride channels of insects and vertebrates. 48da8065a6 Skin disease may result from deficiency or overactivity of immune responses. In cases where there are insufficient immune responses, the disease is usually described by the secondary disease that results. Examples include increased susceptibility to demodectic mange and

recurrent skin infections, such as Malassezia infection or bacterial infections. Increased but harmful immune responses can be divided into hypersensitivity disorders such as atopic dermatitis and autoimmune disorders (autoimmunity), such as pemphigus and discoid lupus erythematosus. 48da8065a6 Though D. variabilis may be exposed to Borrelia burgdorferi, the causative agent of Lyme disease, these ticks are not competent vectors for the transmission of this disease. The primary vectors for B. burgdorferi are the deer ticks Ixodes scapularis in eastern parts of the United States, Ixodes pacificus in California and Oregon, and Ixodes ricinus in Europe. D. variabilis may also carry Anaplasma phagocytophilum, the causative agent of human granulocytic anaplasmosis, and Ehrlichia chaffeensis, the causative agent of human monocytic ehrlichiosis. 48da8065a6

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
