Blood types are inherited and represent contributions from both parents of an individual. As of June 2025, a total of 48 human blood group systems are recognized by the International Society of Blood Transfusion (ISBT). The two most important blood group systems are ABO and Rh; they determine someone's blood type (A, B, AB, and O, with + or – denoting RhD status) for suitability in blood transfusion. 0f27758d17 The doctrine was introduced in 1945 and has undergone some changes since then. Red blood cells (RBC) contain hemoglobin and supply the cells of the body with oxygen. White blood cells are not commonly used during transfusions, but they are part of the immune system and also fight infections. Plasma is the "yellowish" liquid part of blood, which acts as a buffer and contains proteins and other important substances needed for the body's overall health. Platelets are involved in blood clotting, preventing the body from bleeding. Before these components were known, doctors believed that blood was homogeneous. most blood donors are unpaid volunteers who donate blood for a community supply. In some countries, established supplies are limited and donors usually give blood when family or friends need a transfusion (directed donation). Many donors donate for several reasons, such as a form of charity, general awareness regarding the demand for blood, increased confidence in oneself, helping a personal friend or relative, and social pressure. Despite the many reasons that people donate, not enough potential donors actively donate. However, this is reversed during disasters when blood donations increase, often creating an excess supply that will have to be later discarded. Infected blood scandal in the United Kingdom reviewed the literature and come to the conclusion that all blood products made from blood donated in the USA after 1978 should be withdrawn from use until From the 1970s to the early 1990s, tens of thousands of people were infected with hepatitis B, hepatitis C and HIV as a result of receiving infected blood or infected clotting factor products in the United Kingdom. Many of the products were imported from the United States, and distributed to patients by the National Health Service. The final report was published on 20 May 2024, concluding that the scandal could have been largely avoided, patients were knowingly exposed to "unacceptable risks", and that doctors, the NHS and the government tried to cover up what happened by "hiding the truth". In July 2017, the then Prime Minister Theresa May announced an independent public inquiry into the scandal, after successive governments since the 1980s had refused to do so. More than 30,000 patients are estimated to have received contaminated blood, resulting in thousands of deaths. Most recipients had haemophilia or had received a blood transfusion following childbirth or surgery 0f27758d17

Blood type A pregnant woman A blood type (also known as a blood group) is a classification of blood based on the presence and absence of antibodies and inherited antigenic substances on the surface of red blood cells (RBCs). Some of these antigens are also present on the surface of other types of cells of various tissues. These antigens may be proteins, carbohydrates, glycoproteins, or glycolipids, depending on the blood group system. supplies of RhD-negative blood are rare, particularly East Asia, where blood services may endeavour to encourage Westerners to donate blood. Several of these red blood cell surface antigens can stem from one allele (or an alternative version of a gene) and collectively form a blood group system 0f27758d17

According to the 2015 surveillance report by Canadian Blood Services, the risk of HIV transfusion-transmitted infection was fairly low: in 1 in 21.4 million

Rh blood group system The Rh blood group system is a human blood group system. Rh(D) status of an individual is normally described with a positive (+) or negative (–) suffix after the ABO type (e. , someone who is A+ has the A antigen and Rh(D) antigen, whereas someone who is A– has the A antigen but lacks the Rh(D) antigen). It contains proteins on the surface of red blood cells. The Rh blood group system consists of over 50 defined blood group antigens, of which the five antigens D, C, c, E, and e are among the most prominent. Blood banks often participate in the collection process as well as the procedures that follow it. However, many deferrals are indefinite meaning that donations are not accepted at any point in the future, constituting a de facto ban.
