Pap test The test was independently invented in the 1920s by the Greek physician Georgios Papanikolaou and named after him. In patients who have had a hysterectomy, the cervix is normally removed and Pap smears are not indicated (unless the uterus was removed on suspicion of neoplasia). Abnormal findings are often followed up by more sensitive diagnostic procedures and, if warranted, interventions that aim to prevent

progression to cervical cancer.
