Zoning is the most common regulatory urban planning method used by local governments in developed countries. Exceptions include the United Kingdom and the city of Houston, Texas. Most zoning systems have a procedure for granting variances (exceptions to the zoning rules), usually because of some perceived hardship caused by the particular... Although mounted Pistoleers were effective against heavy cavalry, they gradually fell out of use during the Thirty Years War.
