Post-anesthesia care unit The patients are monitored typically by anesthesiologists, nurse anesthetists, and other medical staff. After initial assessment and stabilization, patients are monitored for any potential complications, until the patient is transferred back to their hospital rooms-or in the case of some outpatient surgeries, discharged to their responsible person (driver). Providers follow a standardized handoff to the medical PACU staff that includes which medications were given in the operating room suites, how hemodynamics were during the procedures, and what is expected for their recovery. Anesthesia enables the painless performance of procedures that would otherwise require physical restraint in a non-anesthetized individual, or would otherwise be technically unfeasible. **Nurse anesthetist** In some localities, nurse anesthetists provide anesthesia to patients independently; in others they do so under the supervision of physicians. They are involved in the administration of anesthesia in a majority of countries, with varying levels of autonomy, which may include some or all anesthesia services before, during, and after surgery. Allergic reactions to anesthesia  
More recent studies have reported a broader range, that is, 1 in 386 to 1 in 13,000 procedures result in a hypersensitivity reaction. Severe allergic reactions to anesthetic medications are rare and are usually attributable to factors other than the anesthetic. The reported mortality rate from these reactions ranges between 3-9%.  
More recent studies have reported a Life-threatening hypersensitivity reactions occurring during surgery and anesthesia is around 1 in 10,000 procedures.  
Neuromuscular blocking agents, natural rubber latex, and antibiotics are the most common

In dentistry, local anesthetic medications (LA) are often used to control any potential pain that may occur with procedures. Local anesthetic injections are given in specific areas of the mouth, rather than the whole body. Although several different medications are available, the most commonly used local anesthetic to prevent pain in the area around a tooth is lidocaine (also called xylocaine or lignocaine). Lidocaine's half-life in the body is about 1.5-2 hours. The time it takes for the anesthetic medication to prevent pain in the area (speed of onset) and length of time that the area does not have painful sensations are considerations when choosing an appropriate approach to dental treatment. Other considerations include procedural considerations,

the presence of inflammation, techniques used to administer the anesthetic medication, and adverse effects. In root canal treatment, for example, more Lidocaine is required than for a simple filling. f9997738a7 Intraoperative awareness with explicit recall is an infrequent condition with potentially devastating psychological consequences. While it has gained popular recognition in the press, research shows that it occurs at an incidence rate of only 0.1–0.2%. Patients report a variety of experiences, ranging from vague, dreamlike states to being fully awake, immobilized, and in pain from the surgery. Intraoperative awareness is usually caused by the delivery of inadequate anesthetics relative to the patient's requirements. Risk factors can be anesthetic (e.g., use of neuromuscular blockade drugs, use of intravenous anesthetics, technical/mechanical errors... f9997738a7 Regional and local anesthesia block transmission of

While anesthesia awareness is possible without resulting in any long-term memory of the experience, it is also possible for victims to have awareness with explicit recall, where they can remember the events related to their surgery (intraoperative awareness with explicit recall)

Twilight anesthesia During surgery or other medical procedures, the patient is under what is known as a "twilight state", where the patient is relaxed and

"sleepy", able to follow simple directions by the doctor, and is responsive. Twilight anesthesia is an anesthetic technique where a mild dose of sedation is applied to induce anxiolysis (anxiety relief), hypnosis, and anterograde amnesia (inability to form new memories). The patient is not unconscious, but sedated

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Twilight anesthesia is also known as twilight sleep and allows an easy awakening and a speedy recovery time for the patient. Anesthesia is used to control pain by using medicines that reversibly block nerve conduction near the site of administration, therefore, generating a loss of sensation at the area administered. Anesthetists are trained to identify signs if an allergic reaction is occurring. The identification of a reaction is made by the recognition of issues including low blood pressure, hives, wheezing, rash, swelling around the eyes or in the mouth and throat, and other breathing difficulties. Adrenaline (epinephrine) remains the mainstay of treatment, with corticosteroids and antihistamines providing limited benefit in the acute situation... f9997738a7
