it can cause blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates to the groin. About half of all people who have had a kidney stone are likely to develop another within ten years. A small calculus may pass without causing any symptoms. This imbalance causes tiny crystals to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones), in the upper urinary tract. Lithiasis (stone formation) in the kidneys is called nephrolithiasis. Kidney stone disease or urinary stone disease is a crystallopathy that occurs when there is an excess of minerals in the urine and not enough liquid or hydration. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough they may pass out of the urinary tract through the urine stream.

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
