About 33% of deaths from cancer are caused by tobacco and alcohol, obesity, lack of fruit and vegetables in the diet and lack of exercise. Other factors include certain infections, exposure to ionizing radiation, and environmental pollutants. Infection with specific viruses, bacteria, and parasites causes approximately 16-18% of cancers worldwide. These infectious agents include *Helicobacter pylori*, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, and HPV. Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) does not directly cause cancer, but it causes immune deficiency that can increase the risk of cancer from other infections, sometimes up to several thousandfold. Vaccination against the hepatitis B virus and the human papillomavirus have been shown to nearly eliminate the risk of cancers caused by these viruses.

Epithelial cell adhesion molecule EpCAM is also involved in cell signaling, migration, proliferation, and differentiation. Although it is identified Epithelial cell adhesion molecule (EpCAM), also known as CD326 among other names, is a protein which in humans is encoded by the gene EPCAM. Since EpCAM is expressed exclusively in epithelia and epithelial-derived neoplasms, EpCAM can be used as

diagnostic marker for various cancers. All of this points towards the utility of EpCAM as a diagnostic tool for various cancers. Additionally, EpCAM has oncogenic potential via its capacity to upregulate MYC, FABP5, and cyclins A & E. It appears to play a role in tumorigenesis and metastasis of carcinomas, so it can also act as a potential prognostic marker and as a potential target for immunotherapeutic strategies. androgen resistance in prostate cancer. Gallium scan The form of salt is not important, since it is the freely dissolved gallium ion Ga^{3+} which is active. Gallium salts like gallium citrate and gallium nitrate may be used. Due to lack of disease specificity, imaging with radioactive gallium(III) salts or complexes, such as ^{67}Ga citrate, has gradually become less important over time and is rarely used these days. Gallium is particularly useful in imaging osteomyelitis that involves the spine, and in imaging older and chronic infections that may be the cause of a fever of unknown origin. Furthermore, Gallium-68 A gallium scan is a type of nuclear medicine diagnostic investigation that uses either a gallium-67 (^{67}Ga) or gallium-68 (^{68}Ga) radiopharmaceutical to obtain images of a specific type of tissue, or disease state of tissue. The gamma emission of

gallium-67 is imaged by a gamma camera, while the positron emission of gallium-68 is imaged by positron emission tomography (PET). As they are isotopic, Both 67Ga and 68Ga salts have the same uptake mechanisms. small-molecule inhibitors for prostate-specific membrane antigen (PSMA), which are increasingly used for prostate cancer imaging. The gallium(III) is rapidly bound by transferrin, which then preferentially accumulates in tumors, inflammation, and both acute and chronic infection, allowing these pathological processes to be imaged

LFS is caused by germline mutations (also called genetic variants) in the TP53 tumor suppressor gene, which encodes a transcription factor (p53) that normally regulates the cell cycle and prevents genomic mutations. The variants can be inherited, or can arise from mutations early in embryogenesis, or in one of the parent's germ cells.

With competent management, cancer pain can be eliminated or well controlled in 80% to 90% of cases, but nearly 50% of cancer patients in the developed world receive less than optimal care. Worldwide, nearly 80% of people with cancer receive little or no pain medication. Cancer pain in

The vascular (blood) system can be affected Pain in cancer may arise from a tumor compressing or infiltrating nearby body parts; from treatments and diagnostic procedures; or from skin, nerve and other changes caused by a hormone imbalance or immune response. Most chronic (long-lasting) pain is caused by the illness and most acute (short-term) pain is caused by treatment or diagnostic procedures. Radiation therapy It is normally delivered by a linear particle accelerator. Radiation therapy may be curative in a number of types of cancer if they are localized to one area of the body, and have not spread to other parts. The subspecialty of oncology concerned with radiotherapy is called radiation oncology. It may also be used as part of adjuvant therapy, to prevent tumor recurrence after surgery to remove a primary malignant tumor (for example, early stages of breast cancer). non-melanoma skin cancer, head and neck cancer, breast cancer, non-small cell lung cancer, cervical cancer, anal cancer, and prostate cancer. With the exception Radiation therapy or radiotherapy (RT, RTx, or XRT) is a treatment using ionizing radiation, generally provided as part of cancer therapy to either kill or control the growth of malignant cells. Radiation therapy is synergistic with chemotherapy, and has been used before, during, and after chemotherapy in susceptible cancers.
