These lights may be dedicated emergency lights, such as a beacon or a lightbar, or modified stock lighting, such as a wig-wag or hideaway light, and are additional to any standard lighting on the car such as hazard lights. They are often used along with a siren

SCATS typically uses detectors at each traffic signal to detect vehicle presence in each lane and push-buttons for pedestrians waiting to cross. The vehicle detectors are generally inductive loops installed within the road pavement, but microwave (radar) detectors can be used as a temporary measure when loop detectors fail. Traffic collision reconstruction Results from collision reconstructions are also sometimes used for making roads and highways safer, as well as improving safety aspects of motor vehicle designs. Collision reconstructions are performed in cases involving fatalities or personal injury. Reconstructionists conduct collision analysis and reconstruction to identify the cause of a collision and contributing factors including the role of the driver(s), vehicle(s), roadway and general environment.
