People with latent TB do not spread the disease. A latent infection is more likely to become active in individuals with weakened immune systems. There are three principal tests for TB: the interferon-gamma release assay (IGRA), the tuberculin skin test, and the nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT). a5465f9234

It is a frequent complication of tuberculous cavities, which are themselves the primary sequelae of pulmonary tuberculosis, and

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correspond to localized lung tissue destruction. It is estimated that more than 370,000 people worldwide develop an aspergilloma each year. 2025. The cavities of pulmonary tubercles are poorly equipped to defend against *Aspergillus* infection, allowing the fungus to proliferate and form a pseudo-tumor that partially fills the cavity a5465f9234

Infection of other organs can cause a wide range of symptoms.
