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The shield and spears represent the willingness of the Ugandan people to defend their country. There are three images on the shield: those on top represent the waves of Lake Victoria and Lake Albert; the sun in the centre represents the many days of brilliant sunshine Uganda enjoys; and the traditional drum at the bottom is symbolic of dancing, and the summoning of people to meetings and ceremony. Uganda's main sources of fish supply for both the domestic and export markets are the districts on Lake Victoria, particularly Mukono, Mpigi, Kalangala, Masaka and Luwero. From 1914 to March 1962, the British Protectorate of Uganda flew a Blue Ensign defaced with its colonial badge, which featured a crested crane. The first flag proposed for an independent Uganda consisted of three vertical bands of green, blue, and green separated by thinner yellow bands and charged in the centre with a yellow silhouette of a crested crane.
