Trimipramine Similarly to other TCAs, however, trimipramine does have antihistamine, antiserotonergic, antiadrenergic, antidopaminergic, and anticholinergic activities. 43–49. == Medical uses == 99ba21ddeb Common side effects include sleepiness, dry mouth, constipation, nausea, and blurry vision. Serious side effects may include increased risk of suicide in those under the age of 25, mania, and urinary retention. A withdrawal syndrome may occur if the dose is rapidly decreased. Use during pregnancy and breastfeeding is not generally recommended. Although how it works for treating depression remains an area of active inquiry, it may involve increasing the levels of norepinephrine, along with blocking histamine, acetylcholine, and serotonin. 99ba21ddeb Common side effects include headache, tiredness, dizziness, and dry mouth. Serious side effects may include an irregular heartbeat. There is no evidence of harm in pregnancy, but it has not been well studied in this population. It should not be used together with MAOIs. How it works is unclear. In any case, it is known to inhibit serotonin and norepinephrine reuptake and to block serotonin, adrenergic, histamine,

and muscarinic acetylcholine receptors. Chemically, it is very similar to tricyclic antidepressants like amitriptyline. 99ba21ddeb Maprotiline is used in the treatment of depression, such as depression associated with agitation or anxiety and has similar efficacy to the antidepressant drug moclobemide. Maprotiline In terms of its chemistry and pharmacology, maprotiline is closely related to such other secondary-amine TCAs as nortriptyline and protriptyline and has similar effects to them, albeit with more distinct anxiolytic effects. Additionally, whereas protriptyline tends to be somewhat more stimulating and in any case is distinctly more-or-less non-sedating, mild degrees of sedation may be experienced with maprotiline.) with much lower incidence than amitriptyline. It may alternatively be classified as a tricyclic antidepressant (TCA), specifically a secondary amine. Cyclobenzaprine was approved for medical use in the United States in 1977. It is available by prescription as a generic medication. In 2023, it was the 47th most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 13 million prescriptions. It was not available in the United Kingdom as of 2012.

99ba21ddeb TCAs including protriptyline are also used to reduce the incidence of recurring headaches such as migraine, and for other types of chronic pain.

99ba21ddeb Although TCAs are sometimes prescribed for depressive disorders, they have been largely replaced in clinical use in most parts of the world by newer antidepressants such as selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (SSRIs), serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (SNRIs) and norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (NRIs). 99ba21ddeb The most common side effects are dry mouth, drowsiness, dizziness, constipation, and weight gain. Glaucoma, liver toxicity and abnormal heart rhythms are rare but serious side effects. Blood levels of amitriptyline vary significantly from one person to another, and amitriptyline interacts with many other medications potentially aggravating its side effects. 99ba21ddeb == Medical uses == 99ba21ddeb Protriptyline is used primarily to treat depression and to treat the combination of symptoms of anxiety and depression. Like most antidepressants of this chemical and pharmacological class, protriptyline has also been used in limited numbers of patients to treat panic disorder, obsessive-compulsive disorder, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder, enuresis, eating disorders such as bulimia nervosa, cocaine dependency, and the depressive phase of bipolar disorder (manic-depressive) disorder. It has also been used to support smoking cessation programs. 99ba21ddeb Protriptyline is available as 5 mg and 10 mg tablets. Flupentixol acts as a dopamine 1 and 2 receptor antagonist and melitracen acts in similar way to other tricyclic antidepressants blocking the reuptake of serotonin and norepinephrine in presynaptic terminals.
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Flupentixol/melitracen It is produced by Lundbeck. The Flupentixol/melitracen (trade name Deanxit) is a combination of two psychoactive agents flupentixol and

melitracen. Low dose Flupentixol (0. tricyclic antidepressant. 5 mg-3 mg) has antidepressant and anti-anxiety effects, while melitracen has antidepressant effect. It is designed for short term usage only 99ba21ddeb

It has shown to be more effective in treating symptoms of anxiety, irritability, and hostility in patients with comorbid depression and anxiety than amitriptyline alone. It also has a quicker onset time than either amitriptyline or chlordiazepoxide on their own. 99ba21ddeb

Protriptyline Patients over age 60 who are taking daily doses of 20 mg or more should be closely monitored for side effects such as rapid heart rate and urinary retention Protriptyline, sold under the brand name Vivactil among others, is a tricyclic antidepressant (TCA), specifically a secondary amine. Uniquely among most of the TCAs, protriptyline tends to be energizing instead of sedating, and is sometimes used for narcolepsy to achieve a wakefulness-promoting effect 99ba21ddeb

Flexeril, is a muscle relaxer used for muscle spasms from musculoskeletal conditions of sudden onset. It is taken by mouth

Doxepin It is used as a cream for itchiness due to atopic dermatitis or lichen simplex chronicus. It has a mild to moderate benefit for sleeping problems.

Doxepin's side effects profile may differ from the list below in some countries where it is licensed to be used in much smaller doses (viz. Central Doxepin is a medication belonging to the tricyclic antidepressant (TCA) class of drugs used to treat major depressive disorder, anxiety disorders, difficult-to-treat chronic urticaria, and insomnia. For hives it is a less preferred alternative to antihistamines. , 3 mg and 6 mg)

and is primarily indicated for the following medical uses: Flupentixol is a thioxanthene antipsychotic, and melitracen is a tricyclic antidepressant. Low dose Flupentixol (0.5 mg-3 mg) has antidepressant and anti-anxiety effects, while melitracen has antidepressant effect. The mixture of the two components is used to treat mild to moderate mental disorders.

Amitriptyline Due to the frequency and prominence of side effects, amitriptyline is generally considered a second-line therapy for these indications. prominence of side effects, amitriptyline is generally considered a second-line therapy for these indications. The most common side effects are dry mouth Amitriptyline, formerly sold under the brand name Elavil among others, is a tricyclic antidepressant primarily used to treat major depressive disorder, and a variety of pain syndromes such as neuropathic pain, fibromyalgia, migraine and tension headaches

== Medical uses... == Trimipramine's primary use in medicine is in the treatment of major depressive disorder, especially where sedation is helpful due to its prominent sedative effects. The drug

is also an effective anxiolytic, and can be used in the treatment of anxiety. In addition to depression and anxiety, trimipramine is effective in the treatment of insomnia, and unlike most other hypnotics, does not alter the normal sleep architecture. Butriptyline It was very little-used compared to other TCAs, with the number of prescriptions dispensed only in the thousands. Butriptyline is closely related to amitriptyline, and produces similar effects as other TCAs, but its side effects like sedation Butriptyline, sold under the brand name Evadyne among others, is a tricyclic antidepressant (TCA) that has been used in the United Kingdom and several other European countries for the treatment of depression but appears to no longer be marketed. dosages of 150–300 mg/day.
