Peaks are listed from north to south and include the four peaks not on the Continental Divide but which are on the 120th Meridian, stretching approximately 60 kilometres (37 mi) due north from Intersection Mountain, which as its name implies is located at the intersection of the Divide and the Meridian cc85e81996

The highway's western terminus is in the provincial capital of Victoria, which is also the Trans-Canada Highway's western terminus, where it serves as a city street and freeway in the suburbs. Highway 1 travels north to Nanaimo and reaches the Lower Mainland at Horseshoe Bay via a BC Ferries route across the Strait of Georgia. The highway bypasses Vancouver on a freeway that travels through Burnaby, northern Surrey, and Abbotsford while following the Fraser River inland. The freeway ends in Hope, where Highway 1 turns north to Cache Creek and later east to follow the Fraser and Thompson rivers into the Interior and through Kamloops. The... cc85e81996
