== Grave goods == In the 2001 Eagle Vision documentary, *Classic Albums: Goodbye Yellow Brick Road*, John said the two songs were not written as one piece, but fit together since "Funeral for a Friend" ends in the key of A, and "Love Lies Bleeding" opens in A. The two were played as one elongated piece when recorded, with the transition to "Love Lies Bleeding" beginning at the 5-minute and 49-second mark. However, the songs are published and copyrighted individually and remain separate entities with separate sheet music. With lyrics like "And love lies bleeding in my hand/Oh, it kills me to think of you with another man", lyricist Bernie Taupin uses death symbolism as an angry take on a break-up song.
