It encompasses the largest and most biodiverse tropical rainforest on the planet, representing over half of all rainforests. The 2006 Soy Moratorium. Soybean production is a major driver of deforestation in the Amazon, with cultivation increasing by over 300% in certain periods. The Amazon region includes the territories of nine nations, with Brazil containing the majority (60%), followed by Peru (13%), Colombia (10%), and smaller portions in Venezuela, Ecuador, Bolivia (6%), Guyana, Suriname, and French Guiana. Over one-third of the Amazon rainforest is designated as formally acknowledged indigenous territory, amounting to more than 3,344 territories. Historically, indigenous Amazonian peoples have relied on the forest for various needs such as food, shelter, water, fiber, fuel, and medicines. Although often grown on previously cleared cattle land, expanding "soy frontiers" directly destroy forests
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By far, the direct cause of most deforestation is agriculture. In 2025 nearly 90% of global deforestation was caused by agriculture, with cropland expansion and pasture creation the primary drivers, this is up from more than 80% in 2012. Forests are being converted to

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plantations for coffee, palm oil, rubber and various other popular products. Livestock grazing also drives deforestation. In 2019, nearly a third of the overall tree cover loss, or 3. About 31% of Earth's land surface is covered by forests at present. Deforestation can involve conversion of forest land to farms, ranches, or urban use. This is one-third less than the forest cover before the expansion of agriculture, with half of that loss occurring in the last century. By far, the direct cause of most deforestation is agriculture. On average 2,400 trees are cut down each minute. Estimates vary widely as to the extent of deforestation in the tropics.
