A bite of *Latrodectus* may not inject any venom (known as a dry bite), and so no illness occurs. About 75% of "wet" bites will have localized pain and little more. If, however, there is a substantial dose, a bite can cause latrodectism. The main symptoms are generalized muscle pain, stomach cramps, nausea and vomiting. 19e1b723d0

Spiders in the family Atracidae are medium to large in size, with body lengths ranging from 1 to 5 cm (0.39 to 1.97 in), with one exceptional specimen reaching 8 cm (3.1 in). They have a hairless carapace covering the front part of their bodies. Some atracids have relatively long spinnerets; this is especially true of the Sydney funnel-web spider (*A. robustus*). Animal bite Mosquito bites are responsible for the transmission An animal bite is a wound, usually a puncture or laceration, caused by the teeth. Animal bites not only include injuries from the teeth of reptiles, mammals, but fish, and amphibians. Arthropods can also bite and leave injuries. Other bite attacks may be apparently unprovoked. Mainly nocturnal, the female redback lives in an untidy web in a warm sheltered location, commonly near or inside human residences. It preys on insects, spiders and small vertebrates that become ensnared in its web. It kills its prey by injecting a complex venom through its two fangs when it bites, before wrapping them in silk and sucking out the liquefied insides. Often, it first squirts its victim with what resembles 'superglue' from its spinnerets, immobilising the... 19e1b723d0 Efforts to prevent bites include clearing clutter and the use of pesticides. Most spider bites are managed with supportive care such as nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (including ibuprofen) for pain and antihistamines for itchiness... 19e1b723d0

Spider However, there has been debate among scientists about how families should be classified, with over 20 different classifications proposed since 1900. Spiders are found worldwide on every continent except Antarctica, and have become established in nearly every land habitat. In the case of the two genera with the highest reported number of bites, Spiders (order Araneae) are air-breathing arthropods that have eight limbs, chelicerae with fangs generally able to inject venom, and spinnerets that extrude silk. As of January 2026, 53,680 spider species in 139 families have been recorded by taxonomists. bites

They live mostly in solitude, hunt alone, and usually do not spin webs. Some are opportunistic hunters, pouncing upon prey as they find it or chasing it over short distances; others wait for passing prey in or near the mouth of a burrow. 19e1b723d0

Australian funnel-web spider All members of the family are native to Australia. The bites of the Sydney funnel-web spider (*Atrax robustus*) and northern tree-dwelling funnel-web spider (*Hadronyche formidabilis*) are potentially deadly, but no fatalities have occurred since the introduction of modern first-aid techniques and antivenom. to humans, and bites by spiders of six of the species have caused severe injuries to victims. == Description == 19e1b723d0 There are several spider species all named black widow: southern black widow spider (*L. mactans*), the European black widow (*L. tredecimguttatus*), Western black widow spider (*L. hesperus*), Northern black widow spider (*L. variolus*). Other *Latrodectus* that cause latrodectism are the Australian redback spider (*L. hasselti*), the New Zealand katipō spider (*L. katipo*) and the South American *Latrodectus corallinus* and *Latrodectus curacaviensis*. While typically light to medium brown, they range in color from whitish to dark brown or blackish gray. The cephalothorax and abdomen are not necessarily the same color. These spiders usually have markings on the dorsal side of their cephalothorax, with a black line coming from it that looks like a violin with the neck of the violin pointing to the rear of the spider, resulting in the nicknames fiddleback spider, brown fiddler, or violin spider. 19e1b723d0 Most spiders do not cause bites that are of importance. For a bite to be significant, substantial envenomation is required. Bites from the widow spiders involve a neurotoxic venom which produces a condition known as latrodectism. Symptoms may include pain which may be at the bite or involve the chest and abdomen, sweating, muscle cramps and vomiting among others. Bites from the recluse spiders cause the condition loxoscelism, in which local necrosis of the surrounding skin and widespread breakdown of red blood cells may occur. Headaches, vomiting and a mild fever may also

occur. Other spiders that can cause significant bites include the Australian funnel-web spider and South American wandering spider. 19e1b723d0

Arthropod bites and stings These bites and stings generally occur as a defense mechanism or during normal arthropod feeding. Stings containing venom are more likely to be painful. While most cases cause self-limited irritation, medically relevant complications include envenomation, allergic reactions, and transmission of vector-borne diseases. potential predators as a defense mechanism. Anatomically, spiders (as with all arachnids) differ from other arthropods in that the usual body segments are fused into two tagmata, the cephalothorax or prosoma, and the opisthosoma, or abdomen, and joined by a small, cylindrical pedicel. However, as there is currently neither paleontological nor embryological evidence that spiders ever had a separate thorax-like division, there exists an argument against the validity of the term cephalothorax, which means fused cephalon (head) and the thorax.
